

Day 1

Fly to Xian Tang Dynasty Show

On arrival our local representative will be waiting outside the customs area to welcome you and to take you to your hotel (Check-in after 14.00 hrs.). In the evening we take you for the Tang Dynasty Show. Enjoy a performance of Chang'an music and dance, which originated in China's Tang dynasty over 1,000 years ago. Also, walk through a display of various ancient Chinese musical instruments.

Overnight at the hotel in Xian.

Day 2

Terracotta Warriors Shan Xi Museum

Today, we begin the day with a tour of Xian. See the Terracotta Warriors - the tomb of the First Emperor of China. See more than 6000 moulded soldiers, officers, horses and wagons of this famed army. In 1974, near Xi'an in central China, villagers chanced upon what has become one of the world's most astonishing archaeological findings - an 8,000 man army in battle-ready formation, each warrior a life-size figure in pottery made over 2,200 years ago. Later, visit to Shan Xi Museum, largest center for the collection, preservation, research and exhibition of cultural property in Shanxi Province. The museum has a fascinating collection of around 200,000 pieces of Shanxi cultural relics.

Overnight at the hotel in Xian.

Day 3

Ancient City Wall Wild Goose Pagoda High Speed Train to Beijing

Today we take you to the Ancient City Wall of Xian, built during the Tang dynasty. They are 11.9 km in girth, with a top width of 12 to 14 meters, built of grey bricks and are still standing from the Middle Ages.

Later, we take you to the Big Wild Goose Pagoda built in 652 AD and which houses sutras collected by a wandering Chinese monk in India, celebrating the onset of Buddhism in China. Next we drive to the train station for your high speed train to Beijing. On arrival into Beijing we transfer you to your hotel.

Day 4

Summer Palace Olympic Park - Photostop Kung Fu Show

Today we visit the Summer Palace, and its immense gardens, where the imperial court resided during summer. A summer retreat for emperors and a chosen few in the past, it is now the largest and most ancient preserved garden in China, and includes over a 100 ancient pavilions, mansions, towers, halls, temples, bridges and an enormous clear water lake.

Later, proceed to the Olympic Park, for a photo-stop of the National Aquatics Centre, better known as the Water Cube, and the National Stadium, better known as the Bird's Nest. The rest of the evening is free to explore this city of marvels on your own. Later we take you to enjoy a wonderful Kung Fu Show. 'The Legend of Kung Fu' is a unique theatrical production, which celebrates the philosophy and skill of the martial art of Kung Fu through a compelling storyline, dramatic design, spectacular choreography and breath-taking music

Day 5

Visit The Great Wall of China Visit the Jade Factiry Visit the Ming Tombs

Today, we take you on a tour of the Great Wall of China. This 3,946 mile long wall is a symbol of China's ancient civilization and ranks among the greatest monuments in history. Enroute we visit the Jade factory where you can shop for precious stones.

In the afternoon, we continue our tour along the Spirit Way guarded by stone animals and human figures, and arrive at the Imperial Tombs at Changling Tombs, the only existing burial chambers of the Ming Emperors.

Day 6

Guided City Tour of Beijing Tiananmen Square Forbidden City

Today, we take you on a guided city tour of Beijing conducted by an English speaking guide.

See Tian'anmen Square, the largest square in the world. It's the largest open public square in the world, flanked by the imposing Tian'anmen Gate and crowned by a tower with a typical tiled roof and the Museums of History and Revolution. Tian'anmen ('Gate of Heavenly Peace') is the original gate of the Imperial Palace.

Visit the Forbidden City, an awesome 250-acre complex of palaces, pavilions and gardens. Later, we visit the famed Silk Alley Markets boasting of more than 1000 stores.

Overnight the hotel in Beijing.

Day 7

Onto Shanghai Cruise on the Hangpu River

Today we drive to the train station for your high speed train to Shanghai. On arrival we take you to your hotel. Later, enjoy a cruise on the Huangpu River, gazing at the mighty skyscrapers, the Monument Tower to the People's Heroes, the famous Waibaidu Bridge and Huangpu Park on one bank, and the Orient Pearl TV Tower, International Convertion Center, Jin Mao Building and the newly rising Pudong New Area on the other.

Day 8

Guided City Tour of Shanghai Jade Buddha Temple Yu Yuan Garden Pearl TV Tower Acrobatic Show Maglev Train

Today, we take you on a guided city tour of Shanghai. Visit the Yu Yuan Garden, a traditional Chinese park with beautiful pavilions, miniature lakes and bridges. See the famous Jade Buddha Temple. Built in 1882, the temple has two Jade statues of the Sakyamuni Buddha and houses various ancient sculptures, rare paintings and Buddhist scriptures.

Later visit the Middle Level of the Oriental TV Tower. In the evening enjoy an astounding Acrobatic Show. One of the oldest performing arts in the world, Chinese Acrobatics borrows elements from the opera, dance and Chinese Kungfu merging them into a wholly distinctive style.

Overnight at the hotel in Shanghai. (Breakfast, Chinese Lunch, Indian Dinner)

Day 9

Onto Kunming

After breakfast we drive to the airport for your flight to Kunming. On arrival we transfer you to the hotel.

The rest of the day is free to relax.

Day 10

Visit the Stone Forest Return Home with Wonderful Memories

Today we take you on a tour to visit the Stone Forest.

Walking through the site, you can marvel at the natural stone masterpieces and the intricate formations. The magnificent, strange and steep landscape creates countless labyrinthine vistas, including Major Stone Forest, Minor Stone Forest and Naigu Stone Forest, all of which feature stones in various formations. Animals, plants, and even human figures can be found here. Some are elegant, some are rugged, and each is lifelike with its own distinguishing characteristics.

Later we proceed for dinner and then drive to the airport for your flight back home
